NEW EXPERIENCES

This year has been a time of new experiences at Dorothy's House. We had our first return participant, our first referral from a prison and our first non-English speaking participant. We also tested the waters on emergency placements again. Needless to say, the learning curve is steep but our ability to respond continues to improve.

We go to great lengths to prepare for and devise specific programming to meet the needs of each participant uniquely. Census remains our top concern. It seems as if the shame and guilt of asking for help along with the strong pull of independence makes it difficult for participants to make a long term commitment to recovery in one place.

While we anticipate this behavior it is sad to see them go with so much opportunity still ahead of them. This, along with new leadership in the governors mansion and at DHS has us redoubling our efforts at securing approval to work with and care for girls under the age of 18.

It was our initial mission to serve this population and to test the systems of care for girls with specific trauma profiles and we hope to achieve this goal before the end of the year.
